

2. SEISMIC HAZARD OF INDIA

The Department of Civil Engineering organized a webinar on "Seismic Hazard of India" on September 22nd,2020 for 3 hours, through the Google Meet platform. The speaker delivered a lecture on India has suffered four great earthquakes of magnitudes 8.5 and greater, in the past hundred years, inflicting heavy casualties and economic damage. He specifically focused on how Seismic hazard micro zonation studies have emerged as major tools towards our efforts for preparedness and mitigation of losses due to earthquakes. The resource person thanked the organisers Dr.Giri Prasad and Ms.Serin Issac for arranging the live webinar.

3. CLIMATE VARIABILITY AND HAZARDS OF BANGLADESH

A webinar was organised by the Civil Dept, by Dr.Giri Prasad with the objective to understand the importance of Climate Variablities and Rainfall Induced landslides hazards of Bangladesh. The session ended with a round of discussion and vote of thanks and the webinar was attended by around 100 participants including students and the faculty members.



4. PRECAST STRUCTURES

The speaker explained the importance of various techniques of precast concrete. Precast concrete is incredibly dense, and the process used to create it makes it denser and more resilient than other concrete options.
