- ✓ Board also recommended using self study tools, for the important topics beyond the syllabus coverage to have better idea about the courses.
- ✓ Members recommend adding topics related to accident study in the course Traffic Engineering (20CIV641).
- ✓ Members discussed in specific about the advanced equipment to be used in Extensive survey projects.
- ✓ External members expressed their appreciation for the effects made by department to promote mini projects to enrich academic activities.
- ✓ Suggestions and opinions from the members were viewed and arrived to final conclusions with modifications.
- ✓ After incorporating relevant changes, syllabus content for each subject has been ratified and approved by the Board of Studies members.
